We are working through reviews of some key incidents in the hotels. The reviews are throwing up a number of issues, not wholly unexpectedly, including the fundamental question regarding "overall responsibility". In essence, who is responsible for the quarantined detainees. there is not a consensus on this and lack of consensus/clarity fundamentally undermines governance and decisions.

The structure suggests that the Accommodation Commander reporting to State Controller is responsible. However, there is also an opinion that PH is ultimately responsible because the passengers are detained under their direction.
