



Hi all,

Following the PM's announcement re above the EM Commissioner has the role to co-ordinate the planning and implementation of this action

Victoria Police has the responsibility to take the lead on the developing the law enforcement plan.

Victoria Police will have an enforcement role.

Initial planning for the VP policing response can be summarised as follows: As at 2100rs on 27/3/2020. (See attached document for further information)

What we do know:

- DJPR has overall responsibility to develop the end-to-end plan and contact Claire ?? to contact Mick Grainger as contact for further planning
- Direction to be invoked from midnight Saturday and is currently being drafted details tbc
- First aircraft anticipated for arrival 0700 hrs Sunday AM and then 4 further flights through Sunday with last flight at 1800hours carrying an estimated 0900-1500 pax to be confirmed (from AFP Aviation manager Supt Relation prohibition on publication via APAM)
- Similar arrivals are expected for Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday and then anticipate numbers reducing
- Sky bus being contracted to transport people to hotels
- Security guards to be contracted to provide a level of security at the hotels.
- CCP recommendation that private security is to be the first line of security
- Follow up conversation with **ABF SPOC Liaison officer** Personal information ABF role to facilitate process from aircraft to kerb Claim for prohibition on publication (?)
- Follow-up conversation with AFP Liaison officer and Commander Aviation See email embedded for further Incuding -
- Transport to Hotels the AFP have agreed to provide a plain clothes officer/s (police/PSOs) on board each bus that depart the airport to the nominated hotel. The role of the AFP is for a general security/welfare presence only, plain clothes can be casual, must be kitted up and wearing relevant PPE (mask and gloves). Please note passengers would have undergone testing prior to boarding the bus. Any passengers who have symptoms or test positive will be transported separately to hospital. Transport will be required for officers to return to duty post bus disembarkation.
- DHHS to co-ordinate and plan the reception process at the hotels to ensure social distancing (this process may take some).
- Health needs to be identified and anticipate medical hotline to being established to triage calls for assistance (not to overload AV or local health providers)
- DHHS responsible for release procedures including arranging transport to final address

What we don't know:

Details regarding police powers (anticipate the Health and Well-being Act powers) and this direction being drafted and anticipate confirmation early AM on Saturday - or State of Disaster powers if invoked?

Confirmed numbers of arrivals – see estimates provided at this point

Names of hotels (Crown nominated as initial provider that is ready to receive people)

Number of hotels providers within the CBD (Suggested that CBD preferred as opposed to regional locations and to have them close to the testing centres)

Likelihood of people to absconding/compliance

Intention is isolation in the room and uncertain if that allows some limited movement in hotel?

Individual CCTV or other IT monitoring capabilities of the hotel that can assist the security guards monitoring movements

Information sharing (flight manifests) between departments – to be clarified

ADF support – unclear what ADF role – other than to "support us in our planning" Vs PM announcement?

Proposed Victoria Police enforcement role:

Maintain a policing presence at the transfer of passengers from arrival at the hotel through reception process. On-going tasking to support the security guards – patrolling the hotels Providing response to calls for assistance

Resourcing model:

Role for Operation Sentinel – utilise existing surge capacity

Role for ND1 to oversee processing, patrolling and response capacity

Further details of number of hotels, flight arrival times and numbers of passengers going forward is required to prepare the full resourcing model.

Briefings:

DPC, A/C NWM, Cmdr Tum Tully and A/Cmdr Personal Information briefed on above and initial discussions regarding proposed resourcing model.

Next steps -

- 1. EMV meeting at 0900 hours Saturday 28 March attendees A/C Grainger, Cmdr Tim Tully, SPOC Planning Cell manager PHONE IN ON Personal information Meeting should confirm arrangements to including further details re the number of hotels to secured and confirmation of passenger numbers
- 2. SPOC Ops and Planning Task to finalise the overall law enforcement plan (including confirmation of the ABF and AFP proposed actions)
- 3. SPOC Ops and Planning Cells to support Cmdr Tully to develop Vic Pol Resourcing model based on above enforcement role

Discuss arrangements around PM's announcement - effective midnight, **MEETING** tomorrow night (28.03.20). NOTES.pdf>> Designated locations will be nominated and arrivals will need to stay for 14 days. I advocated for CBD hotels as a preference. Focus will be on arrivals at Tullamarine and DJPR (Claire xxx) are also considering private flights arriving and Ports (Include Jet-Base for example). Does it include Cargo Ships?= No Avalon Airport is not included. Sky Bus will be the conveyance of choice (Jerome Weimer - Dept. of Transport). Identifying a workflow process is the focus of DJPR. DJPR will have the responsibility of developing the end-to-end process (Claire XX). Claire will contact me to discuss VP's position on this. The Process planning will be broken into 4 stages (which I liked). 1. Reception Transport 2. Accommodation 3. Return to Community (see notes) Aircrew and arriving cargo ships crews will be exempt I asked question about what Powers we will be acting under. Jason Helps (DHHS) advises that we will be acting under revised CHO Directions under the Community Health and Wellbeing Act. 1735 - debriefed meeting. She will talk to Operations and Planning Cells and Deputy State Police Commander and start to develop a loose policing response. I will connect her with DJPR tonight. Will contact A/Supt REDACTED along with ABF and AFP liaisons to help contribute to a draft plan







2. Actions Arising from the Previous Meeting

- ToR have been finalised with comments made in the previous PCF and the Final ToR was circulated to all Members on 29 March 2020.
- The Deputy Commissioner COVID-19 Videoconference was tasked by ANZPAA, with questions that arose from the previous PCF, which were included on the agenda for their meeting earlier today.
- The AFP Guidance for PPE document was circulated to all Members on 30 March 2020.

OFFICIAL: Sensitive
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- ANZPAA enquired with CASA and Airservices Australia about their approach to passenger manifests for private chartered flights, in light of COVID-19 movement restrictions. Whilst manifests are held for all international arrivals (include private chartered), for domestic private chartered flights:
 - a. CASA is only responsible for regulation.
 - b. Airservices is primarily responsible for private chartered flights.
 - c. Private chartered domestic flights can fly, including across state border, without lodging a flight plan. The system focuses on traffic control.
 - d. The pilot/operator has discretion on whether to lodge a flight plan, and where they do, only the number of people on board are recorded, not passenger specifics.
 - e. The Minister for Infrastructure has responsibility at the Commonwealth level.
- Tasmania confirmed they had address this risk through an order for private flights
 / aerodromes to cease operations to restrict entries and movements in the State.
 Members agreed to examine this as an option in their jurisdiction.

3. New and Emerging Issues

Update from LTGEN Greg Bilton, MAJGEN Gavan Reynold and MAJGEN Paul Kenny, Australian Defence Force

- ADF provided an update on the local arrangements within each State and Territory.
- Support arrangements are in place in all jurisdictions, meeting the specific needs
 of each jurisdiction and ranging from logistics, planning to contact tracing and
 quarantine compliance checks.
- Providing logistical support in some jurisdictions regarding the return movement of Australian's arriving via airtravel and as well as cross border support.

Other emerging issues discussed included COVID 19 modelling by Health departments – with some jurisdictions receiving modelling information and others not; no issues with hotel availability at this time – but some variation in regards to quarantine order restrictions where it pertains to unaccompanied minors or families with minors.

Several jurisdictions have noticed an increase in calls reporting potential breaches of isolation / restrictions.

NT and QLD discussed an App they are working on for contact tracing. This is being discussed through the DC Group.

4. Police Response

Each Member provided an update on current operational / response measures and challenges in their jurisdiction.

All Australian jurisdictions are working on contact tracing measures and are managing logistics of the new mandatory supervised hotel quarantine orders.

Members discussed the sustainability of this "new normal" for a long period, including community acceptance and understanding.

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Crime statistic variations are starting to be seen; as expected some offences are down but others are up (commercial break ins and FDV-related offences) reflecting the changed community behaviour / movements.

The AFP briefed on a task from the Prime Minister to DHA / AFP / ACIC, namely "The PM has asked for a simple dashboard of crime, and law and order issues to be developed – so that he can get a sense of how general crime is tracking, and can drill into specifics such as assaults, DV, home invasions".

The Members requested that ANZPAA liaise with AFP, ACIC and DHA in relation to the task, to ensure system, counting rule, definition, etc, variations across jurisdictions are known and develop a set of metrics for approval. ANZPAA is to consult with the ABS, National Crime Statistics Unit, AIC and Deputy Commissioner's Group as necessary.

The AFP flagged with members that the exportation of prohibited goods, including hand sanitiser, etc, is now a federal offence. State and Territory members were requested to keep this on their intelligence radar.

6. Summary of Action Items and Tasks

- a. The States and Territories to consider the Tasmanian position of issuing an order for private flights / aerodromes to be restricted as an option to restrict entries and movements into the State/Territory.
- b. ANZPAA to work with the AFP to inform the development of the "crime dashboard" for the Prime Minister, collaborating as necessary with Deputy Commissioner's, the National Crime Statistics Unit and the AIC to identify appropriate metrics for consideration and approval by this Forum.
- c. The Australian Defence Force is to join this Forum once a week as a presenter to update the Forum members on their current operating environment.
- d. The Australian Border Force Commissioner to be invited to present to the next Forum.



- 3. Update from MAJGEN Paul Kenny, Australian Defence Force
 - The ADF provided an update on the local arrangements within each State and Territory. Namely in support of:
 - Quarantine compliance monitoring and contact tracing
 - Assistance at border control points in WA, QLD and NT
 - Repatriation of travellers post quarantine
 - The ADF have deployed an emergency medical team into Burnie, Tasmania to provide relief whilst hospital staff undergo a 14 day quarantine.
- 4. New and Emerging Issues



 NSW are continuing to see the release of individuals under 14 day quarantine orders in hotels



- Repatriation of individuals to their home state after their 14 day quarantine orders in hotels.
- 5. Jurisdiction Responses / Challenges



VIC noted their current challenge is the arrival of international travellers, with flights returning from Uruguay and India expected over coming days, and the management of quarantine requirements.

Members discussed that forewarning in relation to international flight arrivals has become a recent challenge, with often very minimal notice, which presented challenges in arranging transport and hotel logistics for quarantine requirements. This issue was being addressed at relevant levels with DFAT and ABF.
